From Nursery to Agroforestry

Ashabhumi Nepal has established a Greenhouse Nursery aimed at cultivating various native fruits in the region. After conducting thorough land assessments with agricultural consultants, we have identified suitable species for cultivation in the community area.

Fruit Tree Cultivation

The Greenhouse Nursery will specialize in producing a variety of fruit trees including lemon, orange, avocado, coffee, ginger, broom grass, Ipil (Leucaena leucocephala), and Bauhinia purpurea. These trees are carefully selected to thrive in the local environment and will be distributed to the community.



Sustainable Distribution

Part of our initiative involves distributing these fruit trees to community members, with some provided free of charge and others available at a minimal production cost.

Moving Towards Agroforestry

As we progress, our goal is to transition from nursery cultivation to agroforestry models on barren lands. Our team of experts will provide support and guidance to community members, empowering them to implement sustainable cultivation practices and enhance land productivity.
