From nursery to agroforestry practice in the community

Through the Greenhouse Nursery, established by Ashabhumi Nepal, our organization has started distributing fruit saplings and vegetable seeds in the community.

Our project From Nursery to Agroforestry Practices is an extension of this project as we plan to grow 3000 fruit saplings yearly, to support the community as well as make a community forest into a fruit forest for wildlife as well to decrease human and wildlife conflict mainly with monkeys. Our goal is to enhance local biodiversity and promote sustainable land use, benefiting both the environment and community livelihoods. We plan to extend our project from Aarukharka and also in Palpa as the problem remains the same throughout Nepal.

Sowing hope :Empowering youth in organic farming

Ashabhumi Nepal is gathering resources to conduct the Showing Hope project whose main purpose is to provide organic farming training to small-scale farmers, women's groups, youth and the community. We want to address the issue of chemical farming and low productivity. This training will take place in different rural communities before the end of 2024

Ashabhumi Nepal is working together with Sunil, who shares a common vision and passion for empowering youth in the farming sector and promoting simple living in his home area

Despite his success in the finance sector, Sunil felt a deep connection to his roots and the natural environment of his birthplace. This inspired him to make a significant career shift, embracing permaculture. Returning to the midmountains of Nepal, he now dedicates his efforts to promoting sustainable farming practices, aiming to improve local livelihoods and foster environmental stewardship in his community.

Sunil recently purchased 3.5 acres of land, where he is growing a variety of fruits, vegetables, and herbs. Ashabhumi Nepal will work together with Sunil in his initiative by helping to establish a nursery, promote cultivation on barren lands, and develop a rural homestay that offers guests a chance to experience the simplicity of farm life. We will also provide organic farming training to empower the local community and inspire young farmers.
