Visit from kanthari foundation switzerland

Ashabhumi Nepal was happy to welcome Tanja and Andrea from the Kanthari Foundation, Switzerland. With their generous support, Ashabhumi has been able to establish and nurture community initiatives, village nursery, the promotion of organic farming practices, and the revival of traditional skills.

The fruits saplings will be distributed to more than 200 families and organic farming training and practices are helping the community while reconnecting with traditional knowledge and sustainability. What began as small steps has gradually grown into meaningful community efforts rooted in cooperation and care for nature.

Their visit offered a wonderful opportunity to spend time with villagers, walk through the projects together, and witness how the initiatives they helped support have grown and taken root in the community. Thank you kanthari for the support, guidance and trust.



Together with the Community



Ashabhumi Nepal continues to work closely with the community to strengthen sustainable livelihoods and care for the land. This season, vegetable seeds were distributed to local families to support kitchen gardens and improve access to fresh, nutritious food.

Small beekeeping initiatives are also being encouraged, providing families with an additional source of income while supporting pollination and biodiversity in the area.

To promote healthier farming practices, soil testing has been carried out to help farmers better understand the condition of their land and improve soil fertility through organic methods. At the same time, plantation activities with the participation of villagers are helping restore the local landscape and strengthen the bond between the community and the land.

Ashabhumi Kalikot Community Nursery Project

Ashabhumi Nepal has constructed two community nurseries in Kalikot to produce fruit saplings and vegetable seedlings for local families. The nurseries have now begun growing a variety of seeds, marking an important step toward supporting local farmers with healthy planting materials and encouraging sustainable agriculture in the community.

As we progress through our model demonstration farm and learning center, we will be showcasing practical approaches to soil health, water management, and natural pest management. These spaces serve as learning platforms for community members to observe and adopt sustainable farming practices.

We are also working to promote native and indigenous seeds through our seed-saving initiatives and community seed bank. By preserving local varieties, we hope to strengthen food sovereignty and encourage resilient agricultural systems.

Through these efforts, Ashabhumi Nepal continues to work closely with the community to promote sustainable and regenerative agricultural practices.
